 - 3. That the unit shall submit provisional certificate issued by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) under Plastic Waste Management Rules, manufacturing of Compostable/Biodegradable products and interim test report issued by CIPET or any BIS approved lab for confirmation of Compostable and Biodegradable Products as per the standards IS/ISO 17088 for Compostable and IS/ISO 17899:2022 for Biodegradable before commencement of production.

- 7 1. That the unit shall register as a producer on centralized Extended Producer Responsibility(EPR) portal within 07 days of grant of this consent & fulfill its EPR liability as per notified EPR Guidelines in case final testing of biodegradability as per IS/ISO 17899:2022 fails.
 - 2. That no plastic carry bags will be manufactured which is banned vide State Government notification dated 21.07.2010 and clarification issued vide letter dated 13.09.2010 and notification dated 31.12.2021.
 - 3. That the unit shall not manufacture banned SUP items in compliance of notification issued by the MOEF&CC dated 12.08.2021.
 - 4. That industry shall not manufacture multilayer plastic pouches of sachets for pouching of gutkha, tobacco, pan masala which is banned vide MOEF&CC notification dated 27 March, 2018.
 - 5. That if the project cost exceed Rs. 44.92 Lacs, the unit shall take/obtain modification in consent to establish after paying fee as applicable.
- (a) That the industry shall maintain effective operation and maintenance of installed pollution control measures so as to achieve the standards prescribed under EP Act, 1986.
 - (b) That any incorrect information submitted in the consent application form or declaration shall make the industry liable for legal action under Section 42 of the Water and Section 38 of the Air Act.
 - (c) That this consent is valid subject to fulfillment of all the other statutory requirements in other Law/Act/Rules as applicable.
 - (d) That the industry shall ensure that noise from the unit does not exceed the prescribed noise standards for Industrial area i.e. 75 dB (A) Leq during day time and 70 dB (A) Leq during night time to meet the prescribed ambient noise standards. Day time is reckoned between 6 AM to 10 PM and night time is reckoned between 10 PM to 6 AM.
 - (e) That the trade effluent generated from the process shall be recirculated in the process. The domestic effluent shall be treated through septic tank/ soak pit.
 - (f) That suitable air pollution control arrangements shall be installed to control fugitive air emissions generated from the process of handling of raw materials.

> 9 1. That no trade effluent and/or domestic waste water will be discharged inside or outside the factory premises into a stream or well or sewer or on land.

2. That unit shall provide adequately designed rain water harvesting structures, to recharge the ground water.

3. That the industry shall maintain proper Pollution control measures for controlling plastic fumes/gaseous emission during manufacturing.

4. That the unit shall comply with all necessary and mandatory permissions from the other departments/local bodies/any other agency in order to comply with the provisions of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 as amended from time to time.

5. That no Single Use Plastic (SUP) item, which is banned vide Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MOE&CC), Government India notification dated 12.08.2021 shall be used in the industry/unit premises."

10 1. That 33% area of the total area of industry premises shall be covered by tree

2. That this consent to establish is being granted to the aforesaid industry to ensure control of pollution from the premises of the industry in accordance with various pollution control Acts, and in no way confers the right to the industry to exit inviolation of the other Laws & statutory permission.

3. That a Sign Board showing the name, address and capacity of the industry as well as validity of the consents should be displayed at the entrance of the site.

4. That unit shall comply with the provisions of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 as amended from time to time.

11 1. That the daily fresh water consumption shall not exceed from 1.5 KLD (Domestic Use-0.5 KLD and Cooling- 1 KLD) which shall be sourced from ground water and RIICO water supply.

2. That the water meter shall be installed and maintained at the bore well to measure the quantity of daily ground water withdrawal and record of the same shall be maintained on daily basis.

3. That the unit shall submit half yearly compliance of all the conditions mentioned herein above.

12 That, notwithstanding anything provided hereinabove, the State Board shall have the power and reserves its right, as contained under Section 27(2) of the Water Act and under Section 21(6) of the Air Act to review anyone or all of the conditions imposed here in above and to make such variation as it deems fit for the purpose of compliance of the Water Act and Air Act.
